Description

The project includes the reconstruction of the Groesbeck Street railroad crossing to a four lane concrete section between Finfeather and Main and includes the addition of traffic signals. The project also includes considerable costs for relocation of Union Pacific infrastructure including new arms. The cost for the UPRR portion of the project is as much as \$500,000 and to date UPRR has not agreed to pay this cost.

Justification

There is considerable traffic that crosses the railroad tracks at this location as it is a significant east-west corridor. It also provides an entryway into Downtown from the west side. As significant funds have been spent to improve downtown, improving the entryways is significant. There are also safety issues with the dual track crossing and oftentimes it is very difficult to proceed onto or cross Main and Finfeather. The traffic signals would increase the safety of these intersections and railroad crossings.
