Description

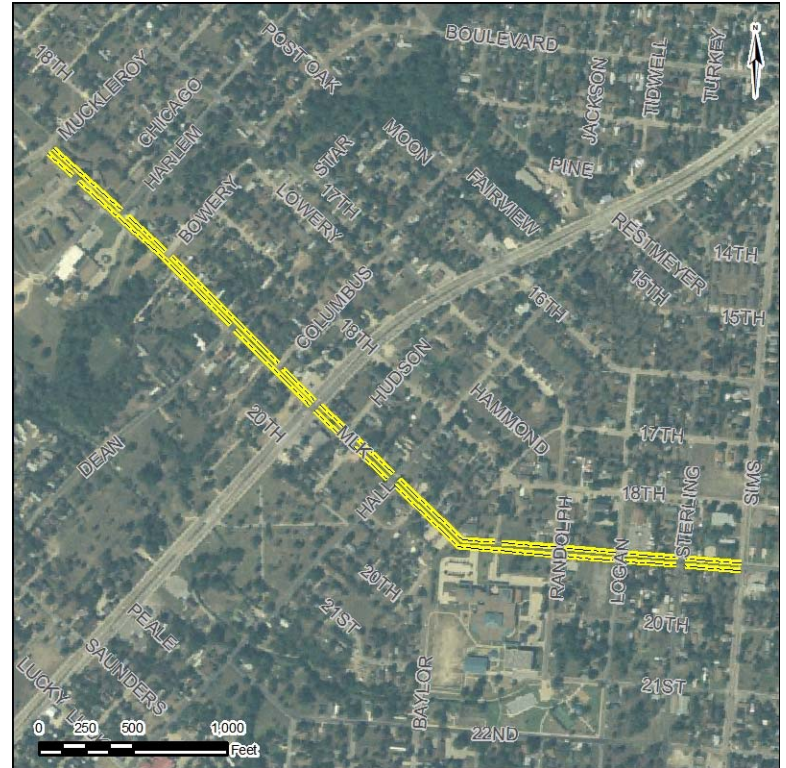
Installation of new and replacement of damaged sidewalks on both sides of MLK Street from Sims Street to Muckleroy Street (about 5,000 ft). Sidewalks to be 6 ft in width where possible. Curb repair as needed, and replacing or installing new street lights where needed will be included. The project may include some streetscaping amenities as the project is developed. The goal of the project is to provide pedestrian access and to improve the appearance of one of the City's major corridors.

Justification

This project will connect areas where there are no sidewalks. The sidewalk connections also connect public schools. There is high pedestrian traffic in this area and also streetscape amenities would assist in the Image Strategy of the City.
